Locker combination – This is included on your schedule. Do not share this information with anyone.

Breakfast and Lunch – This is provided by Aramark Education. There are two different options for lunch. Regular meals are \$2.90 and premium meals are \$3.40. Carton drinks are \$.75. Breakfast is available for \$2.15.

Assignment/Plan Book – You will be given an assignment book on the first day of class. Please use this to record your daily homework and long-term assignments. This also serves as the passbook for leaving class, so it is imperative that you do not lose your books. Replacements are available in the guidance office for \$5.

Dental Examination Card – Please bring your dental examination card with you. You should have received this from your elementary school in the spring. If you don't have one, please ask on the first day of school.

Athletics & Physical Forms – Please see the Athletics page for information on the Family ID system and turn in Section 6 of the CIPPE form to Mrs. McCusker in the guidance office.
